

Social Worker – Support Relationship Profile

Do you have a passion for respecting human beings and their different aspects? Then you have the right profile for the Valcartier Military Family Resource Centre. Your role will be to offer services such as helping relationships, group intervention and preventive activities for military and veteran families. The services are offered to a varied clientele (children, adolescents, adults), related to multiple problems, and embedded in a practice framework based on a community approach. You will conduct planned follow-ups with a short-term vision in individual, conjugal and family situations and work closely with surrounding military and civilian resources. You will work in intersectoral collaboration and with external partners to serve our clientele.

What does the Valcartier Military Family Resource Centre do?

It is a community organization of 65 employees that assists the military community by offering various services: psychosocial services, employment support, support for absences and posting, youth centre, daycare drop-in and volunteer action. The psychosocial intervention team is composed of 9 employees including 2 psychosocial intake workers, 5 social workers, 1 specialized educator and 1 sector coordinator.

What we offer for the position:

We offer you a permanent job doing 35 hours per week, in the opposite direction of traffic with an hourly wage of \$29.14.

Academic and professional requirements of the position:

- University degree in social work;
- Be a member of the professional order (OTSTCFQ);
- Possess a minimum of two (2) years of experience in short-term individual, conjugal and family follow-ups;
- Minimum of two (2) years experience working in group facilitation;
- Experience with youth and adult clientele;
- Availability to work up to two (2) evenings a week (one fixed evening and one on a punctual basis);

- Fluency in French and English, spoken and written (ability to facilitate workshops/groups and conduct interviews in English);
- Understanding of the specifics of the military life (an asset).

Profile required for the position:

- Experience in short-term individual, conjugal and family follow-ups;
- Experience in group intervention;
- Experience with a diverse clientele;
- Be comfortable facilitating prevention workshops;
- Experience working in a community setting (an asset);
- Applying the community approach and preventive measures in your practice;
- Interpersonal skills and excellent disposition for teamwork;
- Great adaptability, autonomy and resourcefulness;
- Strong organizational and priority-setting skills.
