Ted Rogers Scholarship Fund

The Ted Rogers Scholarship Fund aims to provide access to post-secondary education and reward youth who demonstrate community leadership. This fund will support 150 scholarships in 2019. They are valued at \$2500 per year in Saskatchewan (limitations only within Quebec).

An eligible applicant must be: a Canadian citizen or permanent resident, a participant in a Rogers' community partner association, and entering into full-time studies at a Canadian university, college, or trades school.

The application process is completed through the MFRC. Only 3 applicants can be processed. Contact Heidi for more information.
