

## Social Worker – Group Intervention Profile

From time to time, you will offer short-term individual, conjugal and family counselling services while working in close collaboration with surrounding military and civilian resources. The services are offered to a varied clientele (children, adolescents, adults), related to multiple problems, and embedded in a practice framework based on a community approach. You will work collaboratively across sectors and with external partners to serve our clientele.

### **What does the Valcartier Military Family Resource Centre do?**

It is a community organization of 65 employees that assists the military community by offering various services: psychosocial services, employment support, support for absences and posting, youth centre, daycare drop-in and volunteer action. The psychosocial intervention team is composed of 9 employees including 2 psychosocial intake workers, 5 social workers, 1 specialized educator and 1 sector coordinator.

### **What we offer for the position:**

We offer you a permanent job doing 35 hours per week, in the opposite direction of traffic with an hourly wage of \$29.14.

### **Academic and professional requirements of the position:**

- University degree in social work;
- Be a member of the professional order (OTSTCFQ);
- Minimum of two (2) years experience working in group facilitation;
- Possess a minimum of three (2) years of experience in short-term individual, conjugal and family follow-ups;
- Experience with youth and adult clientele;
- Available evenings: Varies from one week to another between zero (0) and two (2) evenings per week;

- Fluent in French and English, spoken and written (ability to facilitate workshops/groups and conduct interviews in English);
- Understanding particularities of the military life (an asset).

**Profile required for the position:**

- Diversified experience in collective intervention with multiple age groups and psychosocial issues;
- Experience with a diverse clientele;
- Experience in short-term individual, conjugal and family follow-ups;
- - Experience working in a community setting (an asset);
- Applying the community approach and preventive measures in your practice;
- Ease in giving virtual workshops;
- Interpersonal skills and excellent disposition for teamwork;
- Good adaptability, autonomy and resourcefulness;
- Strong organizational and priority-setting skills;
